

## Finding objects

### Learning objectives

- Unblocking
- Language acquisition
- Encouraging multisensorial learning
- Discovering the exchange's location

### Number of participants

Minimum: 10

### Duration

About 30 minutes

### Material

Small pieces of paper each marked with one letter of the alphabet; pens

### Description

The participants form duos or trios (in the case of a trilateral exchange). Each group receives two or three letters and must find and gather objects starting with the letters on their papers, in the different represented languages. An exhibition corner is set up in the seminar room; each duo is asked to display their objects along with small pieces of paper on which they write the name of each object in the various languages. They will also present them orally.



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### Observations

The letters and vowels most frequently used can be doubled, and more uncommon letters such as x or y (depending on the language) should be avoided. It is also important to consider the different alphabets.
