

## Morning rituals

### Learning objectives

- Systematisation
- Working in tandems
- Pronunciation exercise
- Communication

### Number of participants

Preferably an even number

### Duration

25 minutes

### Material

None

### Description

The explanations are given to the whole group. The participants then form duos in which both languages are represented, and with people with whom they haven't necessarily had a lot of contact before the game.

This game follows the logic of a mirror. In each tandem, one participant tells, in their own mother language, what they do in the morning, from the moment they wake up until the moment they leave the house; they also mime what they are saying. Their partner acts like a mirror, i.e. repeats the gestures and the words.



## Morning rituals

The facilitation team can give an example: « The alarm rings. I get up. Etc. » The idea is to connect an action/a movement and a language. After ten minutes, the participants switch roles.

In the end, the facilitation team can ask if a duo wants to make a presentation in front of the whole group.

### Observations

The participants must use clear and short sentences. In the duo, one person teaches and the other learns and then vice versa, and both roles are important in the learning process.
