GOAL

- Language acquisition
- Multilingualism

TARGET GROUP

All groups

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

5 to 30 participants

DURATION

15 minutes

TECHNICALITIES

Stable internet and computer; slides or a visual document with the presentation of the numbers in the 2 different languages.

EQUIPMENT

The team will have to share their screen

EXERCISE DESCRIPTION

Step 1: To learn the numbers from 1 to 5 in the different languages. The facilitators share the slides or visual document and pronounce the words in the 2 languages, the participants repeat each word 3 times. The facilitators write the numbers in the chat, so that each participant can access it if they need it during the animation.

Step 2: The facilitators choose a language and explain the activity with an example. They show a number with their fingers, to everybody. They ask one participant to say the number in the chosen language. This participant answers. Then the participant chooses a number, shows it with their fingers and asks another participant to find the number and to continue the activity. When the round is over in one language, you can start the second round in the other language.

- Extending from 6 to 10 and more

It's possible to reproduce this activity with more numbers, for instance from 5 to 10 or even more.

- Using Kahoot.com

It's possible to enrich the activity with a quizz on Kahoot, for better memorization of the words, by seeing them written.

- Creating a grid with the numbers

A grid could be made, depending on the number of participants. For example from 1 to 4 in one language horizontally and from 1 to 4 in another language. The names of the participants are then in the grid. Then one person from the group names a number in each language and calls a participant with the two numbers. They then say the next two numbers, etc.

- To go deeper: use the padlet : To go more in depth after this language animation, we suggest participants to complete a padlet representing a card with the numbers of languages they know, by recording an audio that they will place on the region. The world map format allows several additions for the same language or the same country and shows the diversity of accents and languages on the same territory.

This instruction can also be supplemented by adding a photo of a typical object. For a photo of 1 object, the audio will be 1+ object name in that language. For a photo with 2 objects, the audio will be 2 + object name and so on.
